### Checking In

Upon arrival at the YMCA Blue Ridge Assembly, on Monday, July 11<sup>th</sup>, come to **Eureka Hall** to complete registration. Camp registration is between **12:00 p.m.** and **2:00 p.m.** **The program officially begins with the Opening Team Meeting at 3:00 p.m.**

The following items listed below are needed to complete your registration at check-in:

- **Funds for Remaining Balance**
- **Student Permission Waiver Form**
- **Blue Ridge Assembly Waiver Form**

### If you registered online, both waivers are complete.

If you did not register online, it is **required** for the waivers to be completed and signed by a parent or legal guardian in order to participate in activities at camp.

**Students will not be allowed to participate in camp without them.**

### Early Arrival

Camp housing will not be available until after 12 p.m., Monday, July 11<sup>th</sup>. The first camp meal is Monday evening at 6:15 p.m. **Any housing or meals prior to Monday's dinner will have to be arranged and paid for by the camper. Please eat lunch before arriving on campus for check-in.**

### Fees

**All unpaid fees are due before check-in at camp.**

Cancellations can be made as late as the time of on-site check-in by calling the Camp Registrar, Katherine Fallis, at **(910) 620-9361**. All fees, **EXCEPT A \$100 DEPOSIT**, will be refunded in August if you cancel your enrollment before July 11.

Substitutions can be made as late as the time of on-site check-in.

**After camp begins, \$400 is non-refundable, if you do not attend!**

## Directions

**From the west:** From I-40 East: Take exit 64 for Black Mountain/Montreat. Turn right at bottom of ramp. Take Highway 9 South past Ingles Market to the fork in the road and veer right on to Blue Ridge Road. Drive .9 miles and turn left at the YMCA Blue Ridge Assembly sign onto Blue Ridge Assembly Rd. Proceed to the end of the road and our entrance.

From US 70/Tunnel Road: Head east towards Black Mountain. Across from Health Ridge Pharmacy turn right onto Blue Ridge Road. Go .5 miles and turn right at the YMCA Blue Ridge Assembly sign onto Blue Ridge Assembly Road. Proceed to the end of the road and our entrance. Follow signs to Registration/Guest Check-in.

**From the east:** From I-40 West: Take exit 64 for Black Mountain/Montreat. Turn left at bottom of ramp. Take Highway 9 South past Ingles Market to the fork in the road and veer right on to Blue Ridge Road. Drive .9 miles and turn left at the YMCA Blue Ridge Assembly sign onto Blue Ridge Assembly Rd. Proceed to the end of the road and our entrance.

From US 70/Tunnel Road: Head west towards Asheville. Across from Health Ridge Pharmacy turn left onto Blue Ridge Road. Go .5 miles and turn right at the YMCA Blue Ridge Assembly sign onto Blue Ridge Assembly Road. Proceed to the end of the road and our entrance. Follow signs to Registration/Guest Check-in.

## Shopping FCA

Enrollment fees cover all essentials, but you will no doubt want spending money for incidentals and extras such as FCA merchandise. We will be selling FCA t-shirts, hats, water bottles, hoodies, etc. You will not want to miss out on all the great merchandise!

## Insurance

## What to Wear and Bring

Modest athletic attire (no "Soffe" shorts with writing) is required during camp. Keep your clothing and any equipment simple. Bring tennis shoes and clothing that you will need for competitions.

**You will need to bring a sleeping bag or sheets & a blanket for a single mattress, pillow, pillowcase, bug spray, towels, washcloths, soap and an alarm clock.**

You may want to bring your own water bottle, small backpack (available at Camp Store), and sun block. A notebook and pen or pencil will be needed for the Team Meetings.

Adults and children should bring suitable clothing and shoes for sports.

**Do not bring jewelry, iPods, video games, or other expensive items that you don't want walking away. FCA is not responsible for any lost or stolen property or merchandise of each camper.**

## Departing Camp
